This induction/basic course of Dynamic Positioning (DP) System involves both the theory and practice of DP Operation on a simulated DP System and is primarily designed to provide the training experience and safety aspects necessary for a DP Personnel/Operator.

COURSE AIMS & OBJECTIVES: By the end of the course, the candidate should be able to:

- acquire essential principles of Dynamic Positioning (DP);
- properly set up and practically operate DP equipment and position reference system;
- recognize and respond to the various alarms, warning and information messages;
- relate the DP installation to the ship systems, e.g. power supply, manoeuvring facilities, available position reference system, and nature of work; and
- relate DP operations to the existing environmental conditions of wind, Sea State, current, and vessel movement.

COVERAGE / PROGRAM FOCUS: Emphasis of instruction and exercise activities deals with the following subject and training areas:

- Principles of DP
- Elements of a DP System
- Practical Operation of a DP System
- Position Reference Systems
- Environment Sensors and Ancillary Equipment
- Power Generation, Supply and Propulsion
- Operation using DP
- Supplementary Topics including Human Elements in DP Operations

METHOD: Combination of theoretical and practical instructions in appropriate arrangement and sequence reinforced with hands-on activities and exercises.
