PLANNED MAINTENANCE SYSTEM

This course is intended for Deck & Engine Officers as well as Ship Managers. TM Maintenance & Inventory is a powerful maintenance management and spare part control system. The course provides elementary knowledge of every-day use of TM Master v2 onboard the vessel and gives a presentation of main functions and features of the system. The emphasis of training and instruction deals with the following course units: Maintenance, Alarm Systems, Class Related Jobs, Components, and Ordering & Stock.

COURSE AIMS & OBJECTIVES: This course introduces the main functions & features of the system and shall enable participants to familiarize with the everyday use of TM Master v2 onboard the vessel. Upon completion of the training, participants will learn how to navigate in TM Master v2 system and retrieve necessary information for maintenance and ordering.

COVERAGE / PROGRAM FOCUS: Course includes introduction to use of:

- **Introduction to TM Master v2:** Navigate, Learn techniques like filer, search, grouping to "find just what you are looking for"
- **Maintenance due schedule with focus on:** Planning ahead, Class related jobs, Postpone jobs
- **Signing out and handling of jobs:** Create service reports, Add one time jobs
- **Searching maintenance history:** Jobs done on a specific component, Class related jobs
- **Administrating spare parts:** Withdrawing, Ordering
- **Component system:** Mount and unmount circulating components, Create new component, Copy component
- **Update running hours**
- **Purchasing:** Consumables, Spareparts, Send and receive orders

METHOD: Combination of lecture-demo, guided hands-on practice, and structured exercises that are highly focused on system's practical application onboard. A computer unit is made available for each participant.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT / TARGET GROUP: Preferably Senior Deck & Engine Officers and Ship Managers. Knowledge of Microsoft Windows basic functions is essential.

COURSE CERTIFICATE: A Certificate of Completion is given to each participant who satisfactorily fulfills the Course.
