This course is designed for gangway watchkeeping personnel and focuses on making them aware and responsive on their function and role in the security system onboard ship. It essentially provides knowledge and understanding on principles and aspects of security and protection system toward establishment of good gangway security and control.

COURSE AIMS: Upon completion of the course, participants should be able to gain awareness and aptitude on establishing good gangway watchkeeping, security and control and consequently apply benefit of this aptitude on job setting aboard ship.

COVERAGE / PROGRAM FOCUS: Lessons and instruction covers the following issues and concerns:

- security aspects and safety measures to protect company properties, resources, and personnel against undesirable acts
- ways and means of establishing personnel movement control system
- standards of ethics, courtesy and discipline appropriate for security guards/personnel
- role of security officers in the prevention and control of drug abuse
- security measures and action to take in cases of bomb treat and bombing incidents
- security and defense measures for threat of terrorism and safety readiness to counter terrorism
- characteristics, proper construct and essential content of security report
- methods of establishing good Gangway Security and Control

METHOD: Combination of lecture-presentation and interactive class discussion supported with visual and training aids of basic security equipment.
