A Bridging Program for Oilers and Wipers

This course is designed for Oilers and Wipers to address the competency gaps on the competency management system. It provides familiarization with the common workshop equipment & tools and performance of basic metal fabrication.

COURSE AIMS / OBJECTIVES: Upon completion of the course, participants should be able to:

- perform basic metal working processes using the common workshop tools and equipment;
- make correct layouts and fabricate simple metal pipe fittings, gaskets and plugs; and
- use the oxy-acetylene welding and cutting equipment and make reasonable weld joints on mild steel plates and pipes.

COVERAGE / PROGRAM FOCUS: This course provides:

- knowledge and understanding of the functions and use of common workshop metal working equipment & tools, as well as the safety practices involved;
- training to develop the manual skill necessary to perform basic metal working, layout and fabrication of pipe elbows, reducers, tees and gaskets; and proper use of basic hand and power tools; and
- training to develop the manual skill necessary to make reasonable welded joints using Unitor gas and arc welding equipment.

DURATION & METHODOLOGY: This 10-day, 94-clock hour program consists of 16 hours of theoretical and layout instruction and 78 hours of practical welding and metal fabrication exercises.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT / TARGET GROUP: Existing Oiler or Wiper

COURSE CERTIFICATE: A Certificate of Attendance and a Course Diploma will be issued to each participant who fulfills the course completion requirements.
