

# DECK OFFICER EVALUATION PROGRAM (DOEP)

**DOEP is an assessment module intended for prospective Deck Officer for operational level or management level position. Assessment items/tools are well-suited and selected to measure and evaluate candidate's technical know-how and proficiency in the area of being a deck officer in accordance with the associated competency requirements of the STCW Code, Table A-II/1 (for operational level) and Table A-II/2 (for management level).**

**ASSESSMENT COVERAGE:** This assessment module consists of:

1. **Computer-based assessment** on Standard Ability Profile, Basic Safety (safety, fire, first aid, and survival) and Deck Officer's Knowledge Assessment at the operational level or management level.
2. **Written, oral and practical assessment** covering the following areas per specific type of vessel (*Dry Cargo or Tanker operation*):

**Operational Level:** Rules & Regulations, Personal Safety, Collision Avoidance, Safety Management System, IMO Safety Signs, Chart Signs/Symbols, Tides, Bouys & Light Signals, Radar Plotting and distinctive areas for tanker operation on the subject of Chemistry, Physics, Reactivity and Fire Hazards.

**Management Level:** Ship Handling, Ship Business, Collision Avoidance, Security Awareness, Personal Safety Assistance, Safety Management System, and Safety (for tankers).

**ASSESSMENT PROCEEDINGS (PROCESS FLOW):** The following rundowns the sequence of transactions/activities a candidate/examinee should undertake to fulfill the assessment module:

- A. Proceed to MAC office and present company endorsement letter indicating the assessment module to take
- B. Fill-up registration form and candidate/examinee profile sheet
- C. Take the computer-based assessment in the following sequence:
  1. Standard Ability Profile (APRO) Test
  2. Basic Safety Evaluation Test
  3. Knowledge Level Assessment for Deck Officers (CES 4.1)
- D. Take the Written Examination
- E. Undergo Oral/Practical Assessment (proceed to assigned evaluator for the one-on-one interview)
- F. Preparation of assessment report by respective assessment officer to be forwarded to endorsing company.

**EVALUATION RESULT:** The assessment details and outcome and its corresponding evaluative marks and findings are formally summarized on an assessment report form. That is, scores obtained in each of the computer-based tests and results of the written/oral/practical assessments are evaluated using standardized rating/markings scale.

A descriptive/narrative appraisal for the scores/ratings as well as the recommended trainings and/or guidance are accordingly indicated in the assessment report.

**DOCUMENT OF EVIDENCE:** Endorsing Company shall receive the summary of assessment report indicating the above evaluation results signed by respective Training Officer/Evaluator and the Training Manager.

**TARGET CLIENTS:** This assessment module is open to all Deck Officers intending to be evaluated in the corresponding capacity/position (according to level).

**ENTRY REQUIREMENT / ADVISORY:** It is highly essential that candidates have initiated review efforts and all other necessary preparations before taking the assessment/examination.
