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NSA Cadets 15th Batch Intake 2007

This year has the highest recorded cadet booking in NSA Project history with a total of 381 Cadets intake (Batch 14). The intake this year is more than doubled compared to an average of approx. 150 cadets from the previous years. With such a demand from the industry and with the limited appropriated funds, the Project has to adjust the enrollment and subscription fee from USD 290 to USD 440. The new rate will be in effect from the 15th Batch intake, and will be used to pay for the BSTC and supplement the training fund.

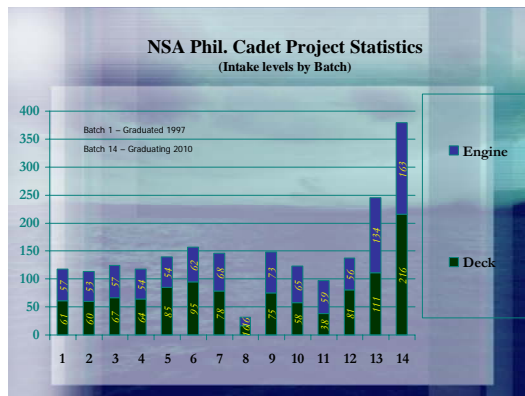
Based on feedback from NSA members the intake for 2007 (15th Batch) is expected to reach more than 380 cadets. A total of approx. 760 full scholarship commitments (14th and 15th Batch) will then be sponsored by the Project next year, however, this implies a necessary supplemental budget. The final intake for 15th Batch will be determined once the approved budget appropriation is allocated.

Deadline of submission for NSA Cadets Booking Batch 15 is on Dec. 31st 2006

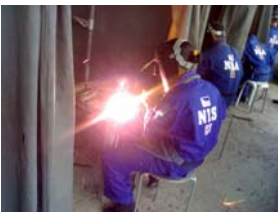

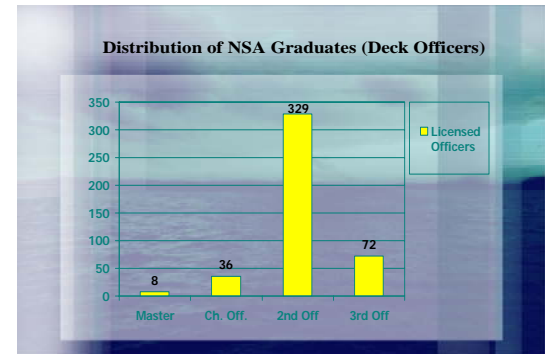
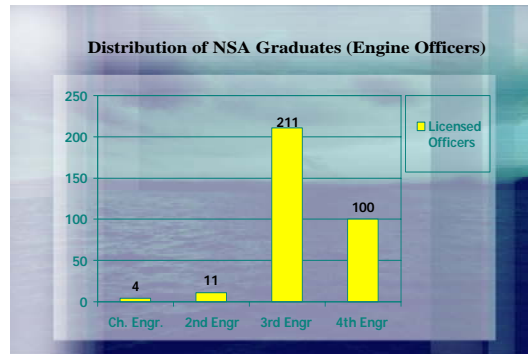
