OIL TANKER OPERATION ADVANCED ACCREDITED BY MARITIME TRAINING COUNCIL

This course covers the IMO requirement for Masters, Chief Officers, Chief Engineer Officers and Second Engineer Officers with direct responsibilities for loading, discharging and care in transport or handling of cargo on Oil Tanker. Accordingly, the course adheres with the relevant provision and requirement of STCW 1978 as amended in 1995.

COURSE AIMS & OBJECTIVES: This course aims to fulfill the IMO requirements for Senior Officers and provide knowledge on safe and efficient methods and routines regarding cargo operations, which in effect, shall enable candidate to take immediate responsibility for loading, discharging and care in transit or handling of cargo on oil tankers.

COVERAGE / PROGRAM FOCUS: Emphasis of Instructions and training deals with the following:

- Rules and Regulations (National and International)
- Basic Physics and Properties of Crude Oil and Petroleum Products
- Hazards and Safety
- Design SBT and CBT (piping, pumping, heating, venting, gauges, etc.)
- Safety Equipment
- Methods and Procedures as to Tank Cleaning and Cargo Operations
- Inert Gas and COW System
- Pollution Prevention
- Ship/Shore Interface
- Emergency Procedures

METHOD: Combination of classroom lecture-presentation and discussion reinforced with training video and tanker simulator.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT / TARGET GROUP: Entry to this course is open to those with relevant experience on board oil tanker (preferably as officer), who have completed an *approved shore-based fire-fighting course*.

COURSE CERTIFICATE: A Certificate of Completion is given to each participant who satisfactorily fulfills the course.
