COURSE AIMS: This course aims to provide general knowledge on the domain of operation and service of Oil, Chemical and Gas tankers. Those successfully completing the course should gain adequate knowledge and be technically equipped for service on any tanker in the above positions.

COVERAGE / PROGRAM FOCUS: Emphasis of instruction deals with the following subject and training areas:

- Design and Construction
- Cargo Containment
- Cargo Handling Systems
- Properties and Types of Cargoes Carried
- Operations and Safe Working Procedures
- Pollution Prevention
- Health Hazards
- First Aid Treatment
- Personnel Safety
- Protection & Safety Equipment
- Emergency Operation

METHOD: Combination of classroom lecture-presentation and discussion reinforced with training video and simulation tool.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT / TARGET GROUP: Entry to this course is open to all Junior Deck and Engine Officers or Ratings who have completed an *approved shore-based fire-fighting course*.

COURSE CERTIFICATE: A Certificate of Completion is given to each participant who satisfactorily fulfills the Course.

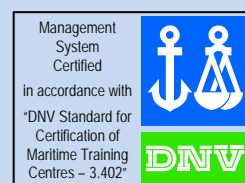
