This course is designed for deck and engine ratings with support responsibility for handling of cargo in Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) vessels. It essentially provides theoretical and practical know-how in connection with cargo work onboard LNG carriers.

COURSE AIMS & OBJECTIVES: Upon completion of the course trainees should be able to gain thorough familiarization and basic know-how on the safety practices and operating procedures normally undertaken onboard LNG tankers. It includes knowledge of the health hazards and emergency procedures in view of the safe and efficient LNG cargo handling and ship operations.

COVERAGE / PROGRAM FOCUS: Emphasis of instructions and training deals with the following:

- Liquefied Gas Production/Methane
- Design and Construction of LNG carriers
- Characteristics and Properties of LNG
- Hazards and Precautions concerning the Cargo
- Cargo Equipment
- Basic Cargo Operations
- Emergency procedures

The training, with the aid of simulation tools, is based on the following functions:

- Monitoring the loading and unloading of cargoes
- Operation cargo pumping systems
- Cargo compressor and associated equipments
- Ballasting and de-ballasting taking into consideration ship's stability

METHOD: Combination of classroom lecture-presentation and discussion reinforced with training video and simulation tools.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT / TARGET GROUP: Entry to this course in open all Deck and Engine Ratings as well as Steward.
