## ACCREDITED BY MARITIME TRAINING COUNCIL

This course is designed for shipboard personnel who will be assigned as Ship Security Officer. The emphasis of instruction and training deals with providing knowledge and understanding of duties and responsibilities in ensuring, implementing and maintaining the security of the ship in compliance with the ISPS Code. Further, the course adheres with Regulation VI/5 of the 1978 STCW Convention, as amended and MTC Memorandum Circular No. 07, Series of 2009.

**COURSE AIMS:** The course aims to provide an in-depth knowledge on various aspects of security and safety for ships and port facilities which covers identifying existing security measures, procedures and operations, evaluation of key shipboard operations, identifying possible threats, and to establish and prioritize security measures and identifying weaknesses including human factors in the infrastructure, policies and procedures.

- Security Responsibility

**METHOD:** Combination of classroom lecture-presentation and discussion reinforced with case studies.
